

CREDIT RECOVERY 2026-2027

Idaho Digital Learning Alliance’s mission is to partner with Idaho public schools to provide innovative, accessible, and equitable learning.



COURSE COSTS

- \$40 per course (public schools; graduation-required courses)
- \$100 per course (non-graduation-required courses)
- \$445 per class (private and virtual schools)

REGISTRATION

- Credit Recovery courses will have ongoing rolling enrollments from 04/01/26 - TBD.

Credit recovery courses are offered on an 8- to 9-week schedule with start and end dates that allow students to complete a semester credit in approximately half the time of a traditional schedule. Credit Recovery is designed using an approach that combines IDLA content and teachers with a district-led, targeted intervention program. IDLA provides the course content, a web-based learning management system to deliver content and instruction, teachers, and internal support staff to districts. Districts provide local personnel to support students with targeted intervention support (such as placement guidance, support, and monitoring), individualized support, physical and/or virtual technical access to courses, and transcription of credits. Credit recovery courses address all required Idaho State Standards and are NCAA-approved.
